


ENGLISH

- Reading – Reading sessions will run weekly on Mondays to help with comprehension and understanding.
- Grammar and spelling – weekly grammar and spelling lesson to cover all aspects of the KS1 national curriculum.
- Writing lessons follow a planning and writing process. Children will also learn to edit their own work.
- Handwriting is taught daily, first thing in the morning. Children will be taught to join their writing from January. Until then we will be writing in pre-cursive, with an emphasis on letter formation.



MATHS

- 5 X a week Whole class lessons. 1 of those lessons will have a reasoning and problem-solving focus.
- By the end of the year, children will know their 2, 5 and 10 times tables.



YEAR 2 HOMEWORK

- ✓ Daily 15 minutes reading to be recorded in reading record.
- ✓ 20 minutes Numbots per week.
- ✓ Spellings set weekly on a Friday tested following Friday.
