Maths

Numbers are worked on each week in a variety of forms such as counting forwards and backwards, recognising digits, ordering numbers, knowing the numbers that come in between 2 numbers as well as finding the one that comes before or after a number. We are beginning to work with numbers to 20, as well as doubling and halving numbers.

This term we will work on simple addition and subtraction, using practical apparatus, including Numicon, as well as the language that goes with each of these such as more, plus, fewer etc. We will also be working hard to learn to write numbers to 20 correctly. The Children will also begin to record their work in ways that they Can explain their reasoning.
