- Welcome back! We were so excited to see all of the children back in school this week and to hear about everyone's exciting summer breaks. The children and staff have been busily adjusting to our new routines in school.
 There are many similarities to life pre-Covid. However, we have done lots of work this week on hygiene and
 keeping everyone safe. On that note, please ensure that you have read the email we sent last week concerning
 the risk assessment and actions to take should anyone in your household be displaying symptoms of coronavirus.
- A special welcome to all of our new starters this week, including our 60 new Reception children! A reminder
 that Mrs O'Neill remains Executive Headteacher, based at The Dawnay School this term. Mr Tuckett and Mrs
 Chalk are responsible for the day-to-day running of The Raleigh. Mrs Chalk is your main point of contact
 Monday-Wednesday and Mr Tuckett is responsible for the running of the school on Thursdays and Fridays.
- In line with the rest of society, face coverings are now optional when dropping-off and collecting children. However, please remember the government's message is to wear face coverings in busy locations and we would encourage parents to wear a face covering, if they feel the need to do so to protect themselves and others. Please also remember to ensure that only one adult per family is on the school site at arrival and collection times, in order to aid distancing. We encourage families to use the 'drop, don't stop' zone on Nightingale Crescent, so that children can walk down the alleyway independently. This is staffed by Mr Allen each morning.
- Please may we remind you to park with care and consideration for our neighbours. On Monday, (day one of the new academic year), a local resident raised an issue about a parent parking across his drive, which resulted in them being unable to leave their property until our parent returned.
- Thank you for staying behind the yellow line at drop-off and collection times. Please remember not to approach staff members on the playground and to write a note in your child's reading record or email the office, should you have an urgent need.
- Good news! All year groups are now able to bring their bikes to school should they wish. Children should park their bikes in the bike storage area by the Cabin (the old nursery building).
