

## **Parents' Guidelines - Remote Learning - School at Home via Zoom**

If a 'bubble' closes as a result of Covid, your children will be taught at home where some of their learning will be via 'live' Zoom lessons. Please find below some helpful guidelines. The structure of the day follows in a separate document

### Frequently Asked Questions

#### **What are the best devices for my child to use with Zoom?**

As long as devices are connected to your home internet, Zoom will work on your home computer, laptops, tablets and even on a mobile phone.

#### **What do I do if my child finishes the work assigned?**

They should then complete the following tasks:

- Complete activities in Mathletics.
- Complete activities in Times Table Rockstars.
- Use Read Theory to undertake reading comprehension activities (selected classes only).
- Explore Libresoft and write a book review.
- Read: we have recommended that whilst your child is at home they are reading for at least 30 minutes a day.

#### **How can my child gain access to Zoom, Mathletics, Libresoft, Read Theory (selected classes only) or Times Table Rockstars?**

Your child's Zoom link will be supplied in an email sent home. Logins for all other online resources have previously been shared with the children by their teachers. If you do not have these, please contact the School Office.

#### **How will my child's progress be monitored?**

We will be able to monitor the children's progress during each Zoom classroom call online and any assessment material completed. In addition to this, the online learning platforms of Mathletics, Read Theory and Times Table Rockstars will be monitored remotely by teaching staff. We will be able to track pupils' progress and see how long a child has been using the platforms for. We will be able to assign/reassign work to pupils if we feel it is necessary. KS1 children can continue to explore these areas, as before, and enjoy the learning activities and games. The children can also monitor their own progress as follows:

##### **In Mathletics:**

In the 'My Progress' section, your child is given all the tools they need to check the progress of their own learning. A visual representation of their results is displayed clearly with a familiar traffic light system. Red activities indicate areas where students need further support, yellow shows that a student is grasping a concept or skill and green areas indicate they have achieved a high level of understanding. To target areas with specific score, pupils can click the eye icon below the progress bars to view a list of activities with the results in that range.

##### **TT Rockstars**

The children are able to monitor their own recall speed and accuracy.

#### **What if I have an issue with the online learning platforms?**

#### **What are the guidelines for my child's use of Zoom?**

There are several key guidelines that we will be following in order to ensure positive online behaviours on the school digital platforms. These include:

- Children behaving in a courteous manner with their peers and teachers while online.
- Children having adequate time away from devices and that they have enough opportunity for physical activity.
- Children participating in live lessons in an appropriate place in their house (avoiding their bedroom if possible)
- Children wearing school-appropriate attire (i.e. not pyjamas) when in live lessons
