

# Playground Rules September 2016

## Lining up at end of play

1st whistle Stand still & stop talking.

2nd whistle Y6, YR & Y1 walk sensibly to Falcon Wing or Walter's Wing.

All other Years enter school single file through door by the Galley.

## Children Inside

You should not be inside school during playtimes. If you have forgotten to put your library book in the box, you may still visit the library, but you will have to change your book next time. The door next to the Raleigh Room is only to be used by children supervised by a teacher. Use the door next to the Galley if coming in for first aid or going to the office.

## Fire Exit Stairs

Do not use if wet or icy

## Cold Weather

Wear coats.

## Eating Outside

Sit down to eat. In summer you may eat your lunch sitting at the benches under the canopy. No eating on adventure playground at any time.

## Lunchtime Games Cupboard

The supervisor on Top Playground will get the play equipment out at the start of lunch play. Play equipment must be treated with respect. If you lose any piece of equipment, let a supervisor know straight away so it can be found. At 1pm whistle take all play equipment to supervisor on Playcaves to be put away.

**Special Friends** Year 6 to play gently with their special friends.

## Chalkboard & Quiet Games Area

Supervisor on Bottom Playground will get chalk & quiet games out of Lost Property Shed at the start of play. Treat all equipment with respect. Chalkboard is on nursery wall, use chalk only. At 1pm whistle take all chalk & games to supervisor on Bottom Playground to be put away.

## Adventure Playground

Check with lunchtime supervisor that Adventure is open. Always wear trainers or plimsolls. You are not allowed back inside, even if you have forgotten to change. The slide is for sliding down only, in a seated position. If you want to play chase games, use the main playground.

## Playcaves

The Playcaves are for climbing on, but not the shelter.

## Football & Netball

There is a timetable for playtime ball games. Ballgames end at 1.00pm.

Football. Each class has its own football to be used on allocated day. 1 football per game.

Netball. 2 balls for shooting practice games, balls found in PE shed. Shooting, only at canopy end of court, to protect windows. The only other balls to be used are with the scoops or paddle bats (small soft balls only.)

## Traversing & Target Wall

Target Wall. Use beanbags only.

Traversing Wall. Check with lunchtime supervisor that wall is open. Always wear trainers or plimsolls. Always climb from left to right. Maximum of 6 children on Traverse Wall at a time. Take turns.

## Field

There is a sign in the hall window telling you if you may use the field. Cartwheels & handstands allowed, but not wheelbarrows. Woodland areas must be used sensibly. Keep away from fence near alley and areas marked 'Out of Bounds.' Do not climb or swing on the trees.

## Multiskills Wall

Play will alternate weekly between football and netball/basketball. If everyone wanting to play agrees, then the preferred game can be chosen. Always play fairly. Allow everyone in your year to join in. If you choose not to join in, then do not interfere with the game in any way. Use only for intended purpose; football, netball, basketball. Do not climb on the wall as this endangers you and others.

*Any misuse of an area will result in your year group losing their right to use that area.*
