Basic Equipment for every day:

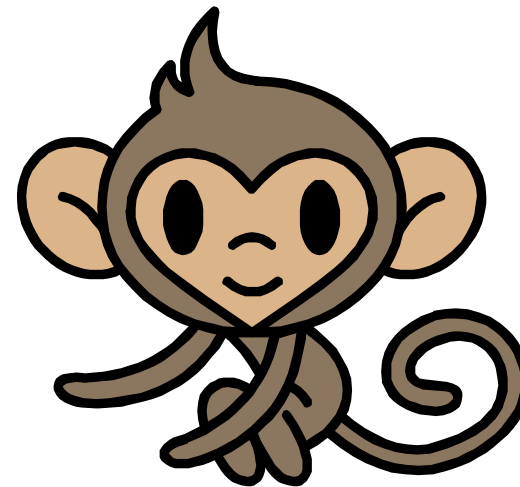
P.E. Kit - shorts, t-shirt, trainers, jogging tops and bottoms (all named please).

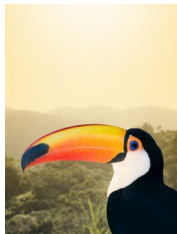
Year 4 Spring
