

Maths

Numbers are worked on each week in a variety of forms such as counting forward and backwards, recognising digits, ordering numbers, knowing the numbers that come in between 2 numbers as well as finding the one that comes before or after a number. We are beginning to work with numbers to 20, as well as doubling and halving numbers.

This term we will continue to work on simple addition and subtraction, using practical apparatus, including Numicon, as well as the language that goes with each of these such as more, plus, fewer etc. We will also be working hard to learn to write numbers to 20 correctly too. The children will also begin to record their work in ways that they can explain.

Chinese New Year Celebrations

On Thursday 7th February, we will be holding our annual Chinese New Celebrations. We will have spent the start of the week getting ourselves ready and then, on the day, will be having a Chinese banquet. During Thursday morning, we will be cooking Chinese food in readiness for an afternoon of dragon dancing and music followed by the feast!

In order for this to take place, we need parent helpers; in the morning to cook with the children and in the afternoon to help prepare and serve the banquet. If you are able to help on that day and have a current DBS check, please let any of the class reps know.

We will be cooking several times this term. There will be small charge for this, which we will add to the cost of our summer term trip.

English

We will be sending home a 'tricky word' book each week containing three common words we would like the children to learn to read on sight, rather than to sound out.

As you are probably aware, we split the children into 4 groups for letters and sounds sessions three times a week. Here we work on phonics for both reading and writing. Each time the group begins to work on a new letter blend or digraph such as 'sh', we will add a new sticker to their book. It really does help them to retain these sounds if they are reminded of them regularly so we ask that you try to look at the whole book 2 or 3 times a week.

We are also beginning to teach our tricky cursive letters this term. Each week we will be learning a new set of letters, which we will be sending home so that you can support your child with this. There will be a meeting to show you how we form our letters and how you can best support at home. This will take place on Monday 14th January at 2.50 in RM. Please enter via the gate to our outdoor area. We look forward to seeing you then. If you are unable to make the meeting, please be assured that we will be sending home a handout containing the information from the session.

Library

Just to remind you that both classes visit the library every Friday. The library system has been rather temperamental this year, but we are hoping that children will be able to take a book out each week. We recommend that you keep this book in their book bag, so that it can be returned each week.
